Feedback Received	Actions Taken
<p>Feedbacks from students were obtained to assess the quality of teaching-learning efforts taken by the College and to observe whether:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The syllabus is completed within the timeframe• The teachers are well prepared for class• Internal evaluation system is satisfactory• Available multiple opportunities of learning are accessed by the students.• Institute makes effort to engage students in continuous quality improvement of learning process. <p>Findings:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Courses are completed to the extent of 70-100% of the syllabus (63% of the respondents)• Teachers are well prepared for class (75% of the respondents)• Internal evaluation system is usually fair (46% of the respondents)• Availability of multiple opportunities to learn exists for the students (12% of respondents agreed)• Institute makes effort to engage students in continuous quality improvement of learning process (43% of the respondents agreed)	<p>Course completion matters are strictly reviewed in the Academic Staff Council meetings and IQAC meetings. Necessary actions are taken to ensure completion of courses within the time. Further, to orient and integrate the new batches of students with the overall curricular and co-curricular environment of the institution, every academic department organises <i>student induction programme</i>.</p> <p>Feedback on teachers is shared with the teaching faculty as a motivation for improvement, as well as to enable them to improve on their drawbacks, if any.</p> <p>The Department of Value Added Education takes the initiative in offering different types of value added certificate courses to provide the students multiple opportunities to learn and grow. The department continuously evaluates and updates the course contents of the syllabus keeping in mind the changing situations. MOOC courses have also been developed for the in-house students. Career Counselling Cell of the College as well as respective departments organised/ organises different events to provide inputs of multiple developmental opportunities.</p> <p>Students are evaluated through offline and online examination system. The Placement Cell takes initiative in holding various programmes like students' seminar, career counselling, workshops on relevant issues like entrepreneurship, cyber-security, etc., motivational talk, spiritual talk, etc. Field works are conducted to strengthen the learning process.</p> <p>Further, the feedback report is submitted to the Principal for necessary actions.</p>
