Outcome of the Event (Please describe within 200 words):** A post-budget in-house discussion on Assam Budget 2025-26 was organized by the joint Initiatives of Department of Economics, Accountancy and Finance on 12th of March 2025 at K.C. Das Commerce College. The head of the department of Economics Dr. Upasana Chakravarty, in her welcome address talked about the key points of the Assam Budget 2025-26. Dr Chakravarty believes that the budget is a welfare-oriented one that covers the areas  
  
of industrialization and there are provisions of welfare programs for the vulnerable section. Principal, Dr. Hrishikesh Baruah, in his speech, stressed the importance of organizing such event that imparts knowledge to all the stakeholders on budget and economic policies.
