The resource person for the talk was Dr. Bornali Borah, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, Gauhati University. The event convened by Dr. Upasana Chakravarty, HoD, Economics and was inaugurated by the Principal Dr. Hrishikesh Baruah, where he addressed the issue of degrading land quality and the ever increasing pressure of mass as there is an
